## SPC SCAVENGER HUNT #2

### What is it?

This is meant to be a fun activity with 3 parts: 1. The search to photograph specific subjects (listed below and at [www.sandhillsphtoclub.org](http://www.sandhillsphtoclub.org) under “field trips”); 2. E-mail your best photo from 4 of the 6 topics by the deadline of May 27; 3. Attend a workshop at the college for discussion of the photos on Sat., June 5;

### Goals:

To get out of your picture taking rut by seeking different subjects and a variety of perspectives; to learn how to critique your work and others; to find out how you are doing in a fun, helpful, tension-free atmosphere; to increase camera knowledge and your skills of observation; maybe find out what “arty” means!!?

**For the workshop:** Saturday, June 5, at Sandhills Community College, Burlingame Room, 9:00AM to 11:00AM. This is the building at the garden center with the ring of children out front. Members present will offer helpful suggestions on impact, composition, lighting, etc. Photographs will be shown with the name of the photographer. Discussion will be informal - this is NOT a competition. Come even if you did not participate in the scavenger hunt. Send your pictures even if you cannot come to the workshop. Find someone else to take notes for you, or email me to say you can't attend. The number of participants will determine how much time we can spend discussion each picture.

Sandhills Community College gardens, open sunup to sundown. A folder is attached with address and information on the gardens.

### Subjects/Topics:

There are 6 topics and 2 optional bonus challenges. You are to select **your favorite shot from each of the 4 topics** to submit for review and discussion by members who attend the workshop. Two challenges subjects are offered. Enter a challenge and you get an edible reward!! Subject choices are listed on the following page.

**E-mail directions:** Resize your photos so the shortest side is a minimum of 768 pixels, the file is not bigger than 2 MB. No title is required. E-mail to [jillmargeson6@gmail.com](mailto:jillmargeson6@gmail.com) Note that this is not my normal email address. I will respond that your picture/s were received. If you haven't had a reply in a couple days, please call me.

The file name should have your first and last name and which topic it is: Example: JillMargesonportrait. Topics are: *portrait, built object, path, flower, lighted, abstract; starburst, all topics*. You can include speed and f/stop info in the email message area if you want. If you have used HDR, or some other Photoshop thing, point it out in the discussion during workshop-or even include the original and final product.
