Remember for this competition you must have wheels, but wheels do not have to be supporting the thing. At least two elements should be in the image: thing & wheel. There is a **3 year time limit** & please keep your titles short and without exclamation marks and hyphens. Standard/Minimal post processing for Classes A-B: **subtle vignettes are allowed.** Unrestricted processing for Class C. 1 or 2 images can be submitted. Titles should start with WHE_A_Smith_Joe_Title. WHE_B_Smith_Joe_Title. WHE_C_Smith_ Joe_Title.

*NEW for Class C: Please submit original plus your entry. *Original_Smith_Joe The competition committee will be submitting changes to the manual before the end of the year, and this process will help us determine what changes should be done. Thank you for your co-operation.

Links open on Saturday, May 11th at 4:00 pm and close Saturday, May 18th at 4:00 pm. Links for submission will follow via a News Blast. The judge for this competition is Don McKenzie (Southern Pines Commercial photographer) <u>http://www.mckenziephotography.com</u>




